It will provide delegates with **an opportunity** to pause and reflect; **explore** and debate developments in our knowledge and understanding of the **experience** of psychosis and its **impact** on the individual and the family.

This will involve a focus on contemporary **research** as well as evidence from **practice** and the policy and service **developments** necessary to support best psycho-social practice. At the **heart of the conference** will be the experience, knowledge and expertise of **service users**, **survivors** and **carers**.

In particular, there will be a focus on:

- New and emerging approaches: open dialogue, mindfulness, recovery colleges, peer support, voice dialogue etc
- The tensions and controversies surrounding new ideas and established practice;
- The changing role of the voluntary sector
- The **challenges of implementing** emerging research based psycho-social practice/s.
